

2009 North Central Arkansas District Fair

Rules for Home Economics Department including Apiary, Floral Arrangements and Flowers, Field Crops & Horticulture, & Educational Exhibits

1. North Central Arkansas District Fair exhibits (except Cut Flowers and Food Preparation) check in on Monday, September 28, from 12 noon to 7:00 p.m. Cut Flowers and Food Preparation check in from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 29.
2. Exhibitors may have only one entry in each lot.
3. Exhibits must be made by the person in whose name it is entered.
4. Entries must have been completed in the last year (Since September 30, 2008).
5. All framed exhibits must be wired and ready for hanging (**no sawtooth hangers allowed**) Wall hangings must have sleeve and dowel and be ready to hang. **These rules will be strictly enforced.**
6. Each exhibit will be judged on its own merit. Exhibits are divided into two divisions: junior (youth age 18 and under) and open (adults). Judges decision is final.
7. North Central Arkansas District Fair exhibits check out on **Sunday, October 4, from 2:00 p.m to 4:00 p.m. No one will be allowed in the building before that time except Department Chairmen.** If the exhibit is removed before that time, all premium money will be forfeited. The North Central Arkansas District Fair Association will not be responsible for exhibits left after check-out. NO NIGHT WATCHMAN WILL BE ON DUTY AFTER SUNDAY.
